Job Description	<p>The incumbent serves as a Coding Auditor in the Louisville, Kentucky VA Medical Center. Contributes to the organization's mission and goals by independently planning, developing, implementing, refining and maintaining a compliant HIMS environment, with emphasis on revenue cycle coding but also on other portions of HIMS coding accuracy, charge capture and program integrity. The Auditor serves as a resource for review and audit of the accuracy of ICD and CPT codes appearing on all Non-VA Purchased care inpatient records, targeted outpatient purchased care services, and those encounters impacting revenue integrity and especially those areas of high risk.</p> <p>The Auditor assesses opportunities for the Purchased Care program on areas such as payment denial, claims payment, adjudication of purchased care claims, establishment of sound audit criteria and program review. In addition, the incumbent provides education, review and improvements related to revenue activities of the facility HIMS staff, Consolidated Coding Unit (CCU) and purchase care clerks. The MRT also performs defined outpatient Purchase care Service probes and monitors to establish consistent claims submission or review and ensures the integrity of the local purchase care program. The Auditor is responsible for construction, design and implementation of revenue and non-revenue coding functions and data capture. Ensure that records are coded in an accurate and timely manner.</p> <p>QUALIFICATIONS:</p> <p>Registered Health Information Technician (RHIT) or a Registered Health Information Administrator (RHIA) or Certified Coding Specialist (CCS) preferred or eligible having graduated from a school of Medical Record Science, or a coding program awaiting the examination, or in the process of obtaining a degree in health information, with previous work experience in ICD-9-CM and CPT-4 coding in an acute care setting required.
